Total amount of certificates traded from June 2015 to May 2016 is 8,74 MLN.
Application via GSE , always open
The average value of TEE from June 2015 to May 2016 was 114,83 €/TEE
Not allowed with other national funding (can be foreseen for ex. within regional funding. Not common.)
Some companies are obligated to guarantee a minimum of TEP/year: - electricity suppliers with more than 50,000 end customers to their distribution network; - natural gas suppliers with more than 50,000 end customers to their distribution network. Obligated parties may satisfy the requirements realizing energy efficiency projects - with the consequent TEE- or buying white certificates from other parties. Other companies, that are not obligated to own TEE, can access to the white certificates mechanism and present energy efficiency projects as "volunteers": • Energy Service Companies (SSE) • Companies obligated to nominate an energy manager (SEM) • Subsidiaries obliged by suppliers





	 Energy suppliers electricity or gas are not subject to Companies operating in the industrial, civil, tertiary, agricultural, transport and public services, including public bodies, if it ensures an "energy manager" or ISO 50001 certificate and will maintain these conditions for all the intervention's technical life.
Conditions of participation	A TEE correspond with a saved tonne oil equivalent (TOE – TEP in italian), the projects are organised in three categories which required a different documentation:
	- standard (with a pre-filled in technical sheet for the request)
	- analytical (where doesn't exist a technical sheet, you can send a project proposal, preflight requests and requests for verification and certification to GSE)
	- major projects (to quantify the savings achieved through the project is required a technical-economic investigation that will be evaluated from the Regional authority, GSE, ENEA, RSE and approved by the Ministry of Economic Development and the Ministry of Environment, Land and Sea. A bonus is given tot he major projects which guarantee one of these conditions:
	• involve significant technological innovations and also substantial reductions in atmospheric emissions (rewarding up to 30% of the value)
	• made in metropolitan areas and generate energy savings from 35,000 to 70,000 tep/year (rewarding up to 40% of the value)
	• made in metropolitan areas and generate energy savings major then 70,000 toe/year (rewarding up to 50% of the value))
Comments	Certificate trading scheme and price are not fixed, complex application procedure.
