Program budget (budget of a whole programme)	Financing of electricity production from RES and CHP is governed by raising funds through a contribution from RES and CHP, which is since 2009 paid by all electricity consumers in Slovenia. In June 2014 the contribution is included in solid, liquid fossil fuels, natural gas, LPG and district heating.
